2. Submission of a birth certificate, Aadhar Card for the child, and an Employee ID for ACC (Regular) employees is a mandatory requirement.
3. The names of the Parents and the Child must match exactly with those on the Aadhar Card & Birth Certificate without any spelling mistakes or variations.
4. Submission of Registration form does not guarantee admission of the ward and is subject to availability of seats & Management's decision is Final.
5. Filled-in Registration Form along with one photocopy of each document, Attested by Parents, to be submitted in Hard copy at the School Office counter from 06.02.2026 to 13.02.2026 (Offline Mode Only) on all working days between 9.00 am and 2.00 pm.
6. At the time of the Admission, all the Original documents are to be furnished for the verification.
7. Incomplete or falsified registration forms, if discovered at any stage, will result in Cancellation without refund of any Fee.
8. The School Authority reserves the right to make all decisions regarding admissions.
9. Currently there are no Seats available for Classes I to X.

General Instructions for Admission:

1. Registration of a student does not guarantee admission. Admission shall be granted strictly on merit and subject to availability of seats.
2. Parents are advised to carefully read the admission notice and ensure that the child fulfils the age and eligibility criteria as prescribed by CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws and DAV norms.
3. Incomplete, incorrect, or late submission of registration forms shall be summarily rejected without any further correspondence.
4. All dates related to the admission process are tentative and may be modified if required, in compliance with directions issued by DAV College Managing Committee, CBSE, or other competent authorities.
5. The schedule for eligibility tests, interaction, or admission assessment shall be communicated through the school notice board or official communication channels only.
6. Admission shall be confirmed only after:
 - Verification of original documents
 - Submission of required certificates
 - Payment of prescribed fees within the stipulated time
7. The following documents (original and photocopies) must be produced at the time of admission:
 - **Birth Certificate** issued by competent authority (Student) - Xerox
 - **Transfer Certificate** (where applicable – Class I to Class X & Class XI to XII)
 - Previous year's Report Card - Xerox Copy
 - **Aadhaar Card** (Student and Parents)
 - Category / **Caste Certificate** (*if applicable*)
 - Recent **passport-size** photographs (student and parents)
8. Any discrepancy or suppression of facts in the application form shall lead to cancellation of admission at any stage.
9. No recommendation shall be entertained, in accordance with CBSE regulations.
10. Parents must adhere to the admission timelines. Failure to complete admission formalities within the prescribed period shall result in forfeiture of the seat.
11. The school follows a strict code of conduct and discipline as per DAV and CBSE guidelines. Parents and students are expected to comply with all school rules after admission.
12. The decision of the Principal / School Management shall be final and binding in all matters related to admissions.
